#### Uniform

# Dinner Money



From 01/04/2002 the cost of a school meal is £2.40 per day. Dinner money for next half term: from 25th April to 27th May is £55.20 Monday to Thursday. Please pay on a Monday as this allows us to balance the budget. If you want to change your child's meal arrangement, please complete a meal change form from the school office. Any changes to meal arrangements without completing a form will need to paid for.

#### Attendance

If your child is feeling unwell or has a medical appointment, please inform the school by 9.30am. If you do not inform the school, a truancy call will be sent out. If a reason is still not given your child's absence will be recorded as unauthorised.

Please ensure your child attends school regularly and does not have unnecessary time off. The school's target for attendance is 95%. If a child's attendance figure is 95% or below, then we consider them to be a cause for concern, as this level of absence can severely affect a child's education

### Extended Holidays

In line with Government requirements and Birmingham City Council policies, we are unable to authorise absence unless it falls within the exceptional circumstance criteria. An example of which would be an immediate family member falling ill and the tickets being booked that day, for an immediate departure.
