Numeracy

In our maths activities, we will focus on:

-Counting by giving the correct number of objects.

-Recognising and making patterns.

-Looking at shapes and sizes to describe objects.

You can help at home by counting in everyday life. For example, How many stairs to get to bed?



What we will be learning

We shall start to teach phonics through the Read Write Inc scheme (RWI). Children will be taught how to say the letter sounds and how to form the letter sounds. The letter sounds we will be concentrating on this half – term are:

m, a, s, d, t, i, n, p, g, o, c, k

The order the sounds are taught in are; m, a, s, d, t, i, n, p, g, o, c, k, u, b, f, e, l, h, r, j, v, y, w, z, x, sh, th, ch, qu, ng, nk
