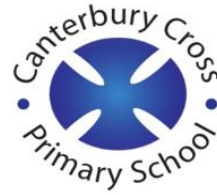


# Year Nursery Parent Planner Spring Term

<p>The children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Develop their social skills by working together to create artwork.</li> </ul>	<p>How to help at home:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Play games with your child that involve them having to wait and take turns.</li> </ul>	<p>The children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Develop their fine motor skills through activities of cutting, sticking, threading and letter tracing.</li> <li>-Develop their gross motor skills through activities of kicking and throwing a ball.</li> </ul>	<p>How to help at home:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Develop their fine motor skills by practising fastening buttons and zips on their coats.</li> <li>-Develop their handwriting by completing whiteboards that are sent home.</li> </ul>	<p>The children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Develop their listening skills by listening to stories and then answering questions about the story.</li> </ul>	<p>How to help at home:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Read the class library book to your child and ask questions about the story using who, what, where and why questions.</li> </ul>

<p>The children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Develop their creative skills by drawing and making different modes of transport.</li> <li>-Mixing paints to make different colours.</li> </ul>	<p>How to help at home:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Discuss different types of transport car, bus, train, aeroplane, bike, motorbike, tram and draw pictures of them.</li> </ul>	<p>Children will be given the opportunity to read and write sounds or words based on what they have learnt during their Read Write Inc lessons. They will also be given a maths activity to complete.
