The Amazon Basin Subject Knowledge

The Amazon Basin is a large region within the continent of South America, drained by the River Amazon and its tributaries. It is covered by rich equatorial rainforest. Within the rainforest live small groups of indigenous people. Manaus is a large city on the banks of the Amazon with a population of 2 million people. It is 1600 kms from the Atlantic Ocean, yet the river is still 8 kms wide. The Amazon rainforest is the largest in the world with 60% found in Brazil. It covers 6% of the earth's surface. Deforestation is a major threat to the ecosystem and contributes to climate change.

extinction	when a species dies out
deforestation	clearing the forest legally or illegally
