

Literacy

Pupils will be reading and writing:

Explanation texts: Understand the importance of grammar, punctuation and word order to support meaning and how ideas are developed.

Stories set in imaginary worlds: Explore a range of texts that are set in imaginary worlds. Explore different characters. Plan a story set in an imaginary world and arrange it into a beginning, middle and end.

Geography:

Pupils will learn about Greece and how Athens is today.

They will explore Athens and look at settlements, what the weather is like, mountains, rivers and tourist places and how Athens has changed.

RE

Christianity- Children will explore forgiveness within the Easter story.

D&T- pupils will make a Bulla bag based on the Romans.

Music:

Pupils will be learning how to use the recorders.

Whole School Focus Targets

Numeracy:

- solve problems involving increasingly harder fractions to calculate quantities, and fractions to divide quantities, including non-unit fractions where the answer is a whole number
- add and subtract fractions with the same denominator.

- Solve one-step and two-step problems involving numbers, money or measures, including time; choose and carry out appropriate calculations.
