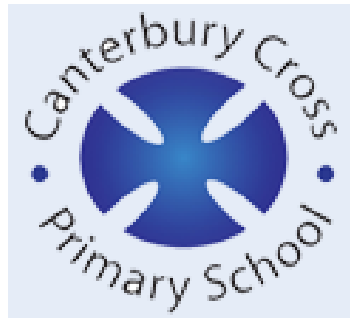

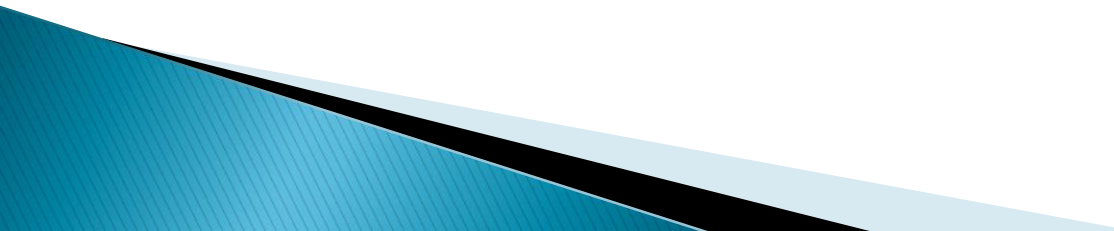



SATs papers

- ▶ Reading—one paper
 - ▶ SPAG—one punctuation and grammar paper; one spelling paper
 - ▶ Maths—one arithmetic; two reasoning papers
- 

The papers are marked externally.

The scaled score changes year upon year depending on the national average of the raw score.

The children will either be given Greater Depth, Expected standard or Working towards the expected standard.

There is only teacher assessment for writing (Greater Depth, Expected standard or Working towards) and science (Met the standard or Has not met the standard).
