This games gives objects to count, numbers to click on at the bottom that when you run the cursor over, the number is said out loud. This really builds on counting skills and number recognition.

Our maths focus will be number recognition, counting out by giving the correct amount asked for and shapes.

The books we will be reading are:

**Superbat** by Carr Matt

**Room on the broom** by Julia Donaldson and Axel Scheffler

**Princess Primrose** by Alex T. Smith

We will be learning about road safety.

We shall start to teach phonics through the Read Write Inc scheme (RWI). Children will be taught how to say the letter sounds and how to form the letter sounds. The letter sounds we will be concentrating on this half – term are:

m, n, w, h, t and d.
